TERMS AND CONDITIONS PARENTAL AUTHORIZATION

This reservation constitutes a contract by which you accept all the terms and conditions listed below. No other bidding document will be given by CD TOURS Inc. unless it is a signed document by the above mentioned. It is very important to pay very close attention to the following information.

Deposit and Payment

A deposit of 25 percent of the total price is required at the time of the registration. This amount does not include the supplementary cancellation insurances or other. The total amount must be paid in full no later than 30 Days prior to departure. If the total amount is not paid by this date, the reservation will be automatically treated as a cancellation.

Room allotments and Hotel Categories

The travellers are responsible to inform themselves of the additional costs that might be incurred if the organisers cannot pair them in the type of room chosen. In general the check-in time is 3:00PM and the check-out time is 11:00 AM. Hotel Category: Intermediary (clean, well furnished room).

Cancellation Charges

45+ days before departure:	25% of cost of trip or \$200 for trip by plane
45 to 30 days before departure:	50% of cost of trip
Less than 29 days before departure:	No reimbursements
Change of name:	\$50 penalty unless 21 days (bus trips) and 4 days (plane trips) of departures all name changes will be considered as a cancellation

Insurance

We highly recommend that you purchase hospital insurance. The cost of the insurance is in no way refundable, and travellers must make certain that they understand the terms, conditions and clauses of the insurance as well as the assured risk guaranties, exclusions, limitations and reduction of guarantees, as well as all procedures with regards to filing an insurance claim.

Required Documents

The travellers are required to assure that they have verified all necessary documents requested by authorized government agencies while travelling abroad. Canadian citizens must have in their possession a proof of Canadian citizenship such as a birth certificate, passport or citizenship card. All travellers must obtain the necessary documents at their own costs, and must have them in their possession before the date of departure. In the case that the necessary documents are not in possession due to a fault by the traveller, the transporters and or the government agencies (customs) can refuse access to board and the traveller will not be entitled to a refund.

Damage Responsibility

All travellers are responsible for their hotel rooms. Before leaving, the premises will be verified in case a breach has occurred in the hotel or the bus, and the person signing this document engages himself/herself to pay the costs of damages. As such before departing the hotel, all rooms will be verified to assessed, and any damaged will be charged to the tenant. Same as damages caused in bus or plane. A \$50 deposit (US) per person is required for beach vacations, and will be collected in the bus or plane before you are to be given your room key.

Claims

You must advise the CD TOURS Inc. representative as soon as possible of eventual claims. In another country, you must immediately advise your representative or the management of the Hotel in order for the situation to be corrected.

Indicated Prices

Other than contrarily indicated, all prices indicated are in Canadian Dollars (\$CAN) All prices are subject to changes without advance notice at the moment of the final payment. A change in price can occur due to the change in the Canadian dollar or due to the hike in petroleum prices, etc.

Modifications and Cancellations

CD TOURS Inc. reserves the right at all times to bring modifications to the schedule as well as to cancel a trip before the departure date for any valid reason including the lack of participants for a particular trip. At the time of cancellation, CD TOURS Inc. will do everything in its power to offer an alternative trip. In the case where CD TOURS Inc. cancels a trip, the agency has a limited responsibility being the reimbursement of all monies received by the travellers. This reimbursement constitutes a final regulation for the damages or other that can result in the cancellation of a trip and results in no other liability on the part of CD TOURS Inc. who declines all other claims that can be made against them as the result of a cancellation and for whatever motive. CD TOURS Inc. reserves the right to accept or decline any potential client of a trip (agency or individual). CD TOURS Inc. also reserves the right at all times to refuse a passenger known to be undesirable. In such circumstances, only the value of the stay (hotel) will be reimbursed (transportation excluded).

Travellers Responsibilities

The traveler agrees to accept all reasonable directives with regards to the trip given while the passenger is travelling abroad.
